- Previous videography experience. It is desirable that you hold a degree qualification in videography/media or are working towards one.
- It is expected that you have some editing experience, but this can be developed during your volunteer role with guidance from the marketing and communications team
- You must have your own videography equipment.
- Photography experience is desirable but not essential
