What you will be doing

- Collecting information on, and taking pictures for, any newsworthy stories to feature animals in press, on social media or in fundraising materials.
- Taking pictures of MSP/MP visits to centres.
- Taking pictures of ambassador visits to centres.
- Taking pictures of staff and volunteers
- You may be asked to take pictures for events at the centre or elsewhere

The skills you need

- Compassionate, patient and caring, with a strong interest in animal welfare.
- Previous photography experience. It is desirable that you hold a degree or other formal qualification in photography or are working towards this.
- Videography experience is desirable but not essential
