## What you will be doing

- Taking engaging pictures of animals ready for rehoming to go on our website.
- Liaising with the marketing and communications team to capture images and/or video footage at fundraising and community events
- Collecting information on, and taking pictures for, any newsworthy stories to feature our people and animals in press, on social media or in publicity materials.
- Capturing images of MSP/MP visits to centres.
- Capturing images/ video footage of ambassador visits to centres.
- Capturing images/ video footage of staff and volunteers

## The skills you need

- Compassionate, patient and caring, with a strong interest in animal welfare.
- Previous photography experience. It is desirable that you hold a degree or other formal qualification in photography or are working towards this.
- Videography experience is desirable but not essential as training can be provided
